SRO Raised a Collective Concern in Times of Pandemic through Pasar Modal Peduli Indonesia

17 June 2020

Jakarta – As a form of support in managing the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Pandemic in Indonesia, the Self-Regulatory Organization (SRO) which consists of Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX), Indonesia Clearing and Guarantee Corporation (KPEI) and Indonesia Central Securities Depository (KSEI) shows its concern by raising funds from the people of the Indonesia Capital Market through the Pasar Modal Peduli Indonesia (PMPI) account at Bank Mandiri 104-000-4028-754. The initiative was welcomed by capital market players including Exchange Members, Listed Companies, SRO Subsidiaries, Investment Management Institutions, Associations in the Capital Market Environment, Custodian Banks and SRO Employees who participated in making donations.

Since this initiative was informed to the Capital Market community at the end of March 2020 until the end of May 2020, a fund of Rp2,887,194,511 (two billion eight hundred eighty-seven million one hundred ninety-four thousand five hundred eleven rupiah) has been raised.

In addition to the grants, PMPI also received donations in the form of goods consisting of:

The funds raised have also been used to procure 100 units of Portable Indonesian Ventilators (Vent-I) worth Rp1,250,000,000 (one billion two hundred fifty million rupiah) which will be donated to the COVID-19 Referral Hospital in need. Vent-I is a non-invasive portable ventilator which is the result of collaboration between the Bandung Institute of Technology (ITB) with Padjadjaran University and the Salman Mosque Trustees Foundation.



In order to have a wider impact in providing assistance related to the handling of COVID-19 in Indonesia, the remainder of the funds received in the PMPI account is Rp1,637,194,511 (one billion six hundred thirty seven million one hundred ninety four thousand and five hundred and eleven rupiah) was distributed to the Task Force for the Acceleration of Management of COVID-19 under the auspices of the National Disaster Management Agency (BNPB) on Wednesday (10/6). In addition to donations in the form of aid funds, PMPI will also distribute assistance in the form of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to BNPB.

Hospital Bed and Ventilator Donation Handover Ceremony

On Wednesday (17/6) at the IDX Building, PMPI symbolically handed over donations in the form of 50 units of Hospital Beds which are products of PT Chitose International Tbk to the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Indonesia (Kemenkes RI), which was represented in the presentation ceremony by the Director General of Health Services of the Indonesian Ministry of Health, dr. Bambang Wibowo, Sp.OG (K). MARS. The Indonesian Ministry of Health through the Directorate of Health Services Facilities has appointed 3 (three) COVID-19 referral hospitals in this case the Regional General Hospital (RSUD) to receive the donation, namely; RSUD Ir. Soekarno Kab. Sukoharjo, Central Java, Kediri District Hospital, East Java, 15 units each and Syarifah Ambami Rato Ebu District Hospital. Bangkalan, East Java as many as 20 units. The representatives of the RSUD also witnessed the ceremony through the media video conference.

On the same occasion, PMPI also symbolically handed over donations in the form of 100 units of Portable Indonesia Ventilators (Vent-I) to be distributed to COVID-19 referral hospitals in DKI Jakarta and other regions in Indonesia that were in need, based on recommendations from the Republic of Indonesia Ministry of Health. Vent-I was symbolically handed over to the Central General Hospital (RSUP) Fatmawati as the recipient's hospital representative. In addition, the three hospitals receiving Hospital Beds also received Vent-I donations from PMPI. The ceremony was attended by the Director of Fatmawati General Hospital, Dr. Mochamad Syafak Hanung, Sp.A, MPH, Director of PT Chitose International Tbk, Fadjar Swatyas, and also witnessed by representatives of the Indonesian Securities Companies Association (APEI), the Association of Indonesian Mutual Funds and Investment Actors (APRDI) and the Indonesian Issuers Association (AEI).

IDX's Managing Director, Inarno Djajadi, representing the SRO in his remarks expressed his utmost appreciation for the support given by all capital market players for donation to overcome COVID-19 both through the Indonesian Caring Capital Market and independently.

In line with IDX's Managing Director, Director General of Health Services Dr. Bambang Wibowo gave his appreciation and expressed his gratitude to the SRO and all parties involved for the fundraising efforts in the form of funds and in the form of goods to overcome the COVID-19 Pandemic in Indonesia through PMPI.

Corporate Social Responsibility related to COVID-19 Pandemic Response

In addition to raising aid through PMPI as a form of mutual concern for capital market players, the SRO also carries out a series of activities as a form of corporate social responsibility (CSR) related to the handling of the COVID-19 Pandemic in Indonesia. On Friday (5/15) as a form of SRO concern in easing the burden on workers in the IDX Building environment and in the atmosphere of Ramadan 1441 Hijri last year, the SRO held an annual CSR activity namely the distribution of 725 Ramadan gifts in the form of a package of basic needs for IDX Building officers includes janitors, security forces, parking attendants, technicians, and others.



In addition, still in the atmosphere of the holy month of Ramadan, the SRO also took the initiative to allow for the allowance of the Holiday Allowance (THR) and matching donations participated by the Board of Commissioners and Directors, and SRO Employees. All employees participated voluntarily to set aside some of the funds from the THR obtained for zakat and donations to the people who need it to accelerate the handling of COVID-19 in Indonesia. The total value of donations collected from the SRO initiative, when combined, can reach more than Rp1 Billion.

Through the CSR program, the IDX has distributed scholarship assistance to students whose parents were affected by Termination of Work Relations (PHK) from the COVID-19 Pandemic, as well as channeling PPE and basic needs to the people who need and are affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic in all regions in Indonesia. The IDX will also distribute 1,500 basic necessities in June 2020.

Meanwhile, KPEI's CSR program with the theme "Together with KPEI Against COVID-19" distributed aid in the form of nine-basic necessities and disinfectant liquid to the Galuh Foundation in Bekasi on Wednesday (10/6), providing financial assistance through the Food for Animals program to the Zoo Association -Indonesia (PKBSI) on Friday (12/6), and continued with the distribution of aid in the form of 396 food parcels for health workers in Tangerang City Hospital, which is planned to be held on Friday (6/26).

Other CSR activities were carried out by KSEI last Ramadan through the distribution of aid in the form of 500 packages of staple food to the people who need it, with the help of distribution by employees. In early June 2020 KSEI also delivered 1,000 PPE to health workers in 32 hospitals spread throughout Indonesia. The selection of assistance to hospitals is based on the urgency of the availability of PPE needed by the hospital.
