**Capital Market Charity:
Indonesia's Capital Market United for Sharing and Strengthening Hope**

February 20, 2026

Jakarta – In conjunction with the beginning of Ramadan, a time for reflection and solidarity, Indonesia's capital market once again demonstrated its social commitment through the Capital Market Cares: Sharing and Strengthening Hope event, held on Friday (20/2) at the Main Hall of the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) in Jakarta. This aid handover event represents the collaboration of Indonesian capital market stakeholders in delivering measurable, sustainable social impact. Through a series of donation activities and a joint iftar gathering, the funds collected amounted to Rp3,957,291,169. They were distributed to three partner institutions: Sahabat Pedalaman, BenihBaik.com, and the Wahid Foundation, which operate in the fields of education, humanitarian initiatives, and the strengthening of tolerance values.

Amid economic dynamics and various social challenges still faced by the public, the collective role of capital market institutions has become increasingly relevant. The capital market serves not only as an instrument of economic growth but also as part of an ecosystem that carries social responsibility. Capital Market Cares was designed as a collaborative platform for the Self-Regulatory Organizations (SROs) comprising the IDX, the Indonesian Clearing and Guarantee Corporation (IDClear), and the Indonesia Central Securities Depository (KSEI), and for listed companies, exchange members, and other capital market participants. This series of corporate social responsibility (CSR) activities represents a shared commitment that the growth and sustainability of the capital market must proceed in parallel with tangible contributions to society.

The theme of "Sharing and Strengthening Hope" underscores that the solidarity forged among Indonesia's capital market participants can be a powerful force in broadening social impact, especially for disaster-affected communities in need of ongoing support. Through this CSR program, Indonesia's capital market plays an active role in accelerating post-disaster recovery across Sumatra by rehabilitating critical infrastructure. This includes inter-regional road connectivity, access to clean water, sanitation facilities, and religious and educational spaces in the provinces of Aceh, North Sumatra, and West Sumatra.

The Capital Market Cares initiative, driven by collective participation, embodies the gotong royong spirit that underpins Indonesia's capital market ecosystem. This collaboration was made concrete through the support for various post-disaster infrastructure recovery programs across Sumatra, including:

- Restoration of religious and educational infrastructure in Aceh through the reactivation of mosques, meunasah (community prayer halls), and dayah (Aceh-style Islamic boarding schools), together with the Wahid Foundation.

- Construction of water wells, communal sanitation facilities, and educational spaces with BenihBaik.com to ensure disaster-affected communities have access to clean water and adequate learning facilities.
- Construction of bridges, water wells, and sanitation facilities with Sahabat Pedalaman to restore connectivity and improve community health conditions.

Through this synergy, capital market participants and stakeholders are not only delivering short-term aid but also actively rebuilding the foundations of community life, from access to clean water and sanitation to regional connectivity, as well as restoring social and educational functions in affected areas. Capital Market Cares stands as proof that Indonesia's capital market ecosystem can deliver impact that is both far-reaching and sustainable. Beyond its role as a driver of investment and national economic growth, Indonesia's capital market has positioned itself as an integral part of an inclusive, solution-oriented approach to long-term recovery.
